

Region 2 Assembly

The Regional Assembly for Region 2 will take place on Saturday, October 18, approximately 8:30-12:00 at St. Patrick's in DC. The guest speaker is Billie Alban, who recently co-authored *Creating the Future Together: Methods to Inspire your Whole Faith Community* (published by Alban Institute) with the Rev. Loren Mead. SCHEDULE OF ELECTIONS AND NOMINATIONS

(All terms of office begin after Convention and end with the Convention of the year listed.)

Election of regional representative:

Lay Representative to Diocesan Council – 3 year term (2012)

NOTE: incumbent is not eligible to run again

Nominations: (elect nominees to run at Convention):

1 Clerical and 1 Lay nominees for Member of Standing Committee, 2 year term (2011)

2 Clerical and 1 Lay nominees for Alternate Deputy to General Convention 2009

1 Clerical and 1 Lay nominees for At-Large member of Diocesan Council (2012)

1 Clerical and 1 Lay nominees for Ecclesiastical Trial Court, 5 year term (2014)

NOTE: Someone may not serve on both Ecclesiastical Trial Court and Standing Committee, nor should they be either on either of these plus the Diocesan Review Committee. Also, it is not a good idea to have the same person on both Council and Standing Committee, each being a large job.

For At-Large member of Council only, you may nominate across regions. All other nominations must be from within your region.
