RESOLVED, that the One Hundred Twenty-First Annual Convention of the Diocese of Washington call upon parishes and schools of the Diocese of Washington to provide educational programs on Islam including inviting a Muslim to speak and discussing how to address prejudice and intolerance of Muslims; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the parishes and schools of the Diocese of Washington and their members advocate for the civil rights and safety of Muslims; and be it further

RESOLVED, that parishes and schools of the Diocese of Washington are encouraged to host or participate in at least one ecumenical or interfaith activity with neighboring Christian or non-Christian communities during 2016; and be it further

RESOLVED, that parishes and schools of the Diocese of Washington are encouraged to report to the Diocesan Ecumenical & Inter-religious Commission the date, nature, and results of each of the three activities.
